	Testing Strategy	Purpose
	Symptomatic Testing	Confirm or rule-out Covid-19 if an individual develops symptoms in school
	Routine Testing (also called "screening", "surveillance", or "assurance" testing)	 Testing people with no symptoms or known exposure on a repeated, scheduled basis to identify people with asymptomatic infections. Test everyone at least 1x/week: consistently breaks chains of transmission and can significantly mitigate spread -or- Test 10% of community 1x/week or less: helps with decision-making by determining how many "silent"/asymptomatic infections are present in schools
+	Test to Stay/Close Contact Testing	Test asymptomatic people with known exposures daily or near daily. Keep staff / students in school - replacement for quarantine.
