Cultivating HOPE Through Testing

With the fear and uncertainty surrounding the health and well-being of students, educators, and staff, returning to an in-person learning environment presented a unique challenge. As factors outside of a normal instructional focus took center stage, a COVID-19 response plan proved to be pivotal. The K-12 testing program quickly became the cornerstone of this plan. Through accessible diagnostic testing, streamlined routine testing, and the detection of thousands of positive cases, the NCDHHS K-12 testing program restored hope by establishing confidence in a safe in-person learning environment within the NC school system.

Committing to IN-CLASS Learning Time

The goal of the testing program was, and remains, to promote and protect in-person learning. By providing equitable access to testing, schools were empowered with the proper tools to keep their classrooms safe. Harnessing the willing collaboration of school staff, met the unique needs of each school. As a result, a typical testing event took only 15-30 minutes once per week, providing peace of mind without disruption.

Consistent Care & Testing Services EVERYWHERE

From Rockingham to Knotts Island, this innovative program provided exceptional service and robust COVID-19 resources to the entirety of central-eastern North Carolina. With rural areas and Historically Marginalized Populations (HMPs) prone to receiving the lesser of both, the NCDHHS program bridged the gap by prioritizing and empowering these populations. Leveraging existing infrastructure was key to serving every participating school with excellence, regardless of the location. Equitable access to testing for all populations was a key to the success of the entire program.
